4. Shop and compare those prices with other wholesalers.

This process should help you find the lowest wholesale prices for the flea market products that you need.

What should you do when two wholesalers have the same price, or are within a few cents of each other?

I would recommend buying your flea market products from the wholesaler who you feel will be able to help you grow your business.

The knowledge and experience that a wholesaler can share with is worth more than the few pennies you might save from buying from the cheapest wholesaler.
